



Carmeuse Lime & Stone, Inc - Site Hazard Awareness Training Erie Sand & Gravel

Due to the hazards of our operations, contactors, haulers, and visitors will follow all safety rules whether or not posted in work areas. Employees will report violations of the safety rules. By signing this document you commit that you will comply with the requirements of Carmeuse Lime & Stone / Erie Sand & Gravel. Failure to follow these rules will result in Erie Sand & Gravel revoking your authorization to be on site. Each person entering the property must receive this training each calendar year. Your signature indicates you are subject to our safety rules, you fully understand our safety rules, and will comply with the following while on property.

Over the road vehicle operations

- Site speed limit is **5 MPH** unless otherwise posted
- Be aware of road conditions and heavy equipment operating in your immediate vicinity
- **Seat belt usage is mandatory while the vehicle is in motion**
- Always yield to pedestrians and heavy equipment
- Follow ALL Posted Traffic Signs (Stop, One-Way, etc.)

Alarms - signs - postings - directions

- Obey all alarms, signs, postings, and employee directions

Mandatory personal protective equipment

- Contractors, Haulers, and Visitors will work with their own PPE which includes:

Hardhat - when hazard exists / instruction is given

Safety glasses - ANSI 287.1

Side shields – for prescription glasses

Safety toed boots - over the ankle

Shirts with sleeves - no tank tops

Long pants - mandatory

Hearing protection - as necessary and in posted areas

Gloves - as necessary

Respiratory protection – as required by task

Loose jewellery & clothing may not be worn while working in the plant

Fall Arrest and Protection

- Fall Protection Harness – Shall be used when there is a danger of falling
- Your full body harness must fit snugly and not be loose
- Required in manlifts, roof tops, etc...

Smoking

- Smoking is prohibited indoors and inside Carmeuse company vehicles, as per Pennsylvania State Senate Bill 246

Slips and Trips

- Surfaces could be slippery - Use handrails, watch where you step, and always use caution when walking on wet surfaces
- Be aware of loose stone – walk cautiously at all times
- Walk around uneven ground

Hazard Communication (HAZCOM)

- MSDS Binders are located at the site – consult with a Carmeuse employee for more information (**Break Room & Office**)

Emergencies and Evacuations

- Contact any employee for emergency aid. Emergency medical services number is **911 (Guard House x247)**
- In the event of an evacuation, all personnel will meet at the designated area (**Guard House Gate**)

- Haulers and Contractors are required to report all accidents, injuries, property damage, and unsafe conditions before leaving the site

Hauler Equipment Operation

- Watch for overhead obstacles (power lines, building fixtures) which could be damaged
- You are not allowed to drive with a dump bed in the up position
- All dumping must be on a flat level surface to avoid tip over
- Haulers and Contractors are not allowed to use or operate any Erie Sand & Gravel equipment unless trained. If you need assistance, contact a Carmeuse supervisor
- Erie Sand & Gravel is not authorized to repair or move trucks, towing and repair is at owners expense
- Possession of drugs, alcohol, weapons, or firearms is strictly prohibited

Mobile Equipment and Pedestrians

- Always proceed cautiously as heavy equipment operators may not see you or your vehicle
- Over the Road Trucks always yield to heavy equipment
- Pedestrians always have the right of way
- Riding on mobile equipment is prohibited
- Notify equipment operators before you enter an area where they are working. Operator must acknowledge your presence

USCG MARSEC Security

- No unauthorized individuals and vehicles are allowed within posted areas
- ALL Individuals requiring access to posted areas are required to be a TWIC holder or escorted by an approved site person at all times
- Access to this facility could result in mandatory screening of person and vehicle.

Contractor Daily Log Sheet

- ALL Contractors are required to sign in at the guard house when arriving onsite and out when leaving the site.
- Upon signing in a pass will be issued. This pass is required to be turned in upon leaving the site.

By signing this document you acknowledge:

- You have received this briefing and understand all training items contained therein
- Compliance with any Carmeuse or government regulation(s) whether listed here or not are mandatory at all times
- Failure to comply with any of the aforementioned can result in ejection from the site and/or termination of your contract
