



HAULER SAFETY ORIENTATION

This form is to be completed by each driver. This orientation is valid for the calendar year only.

Welcome to Carmeuse Lime & Stone. Your safety during your time with us is our primary concern. You will observe during your stay with us that we take safety very seriously. In order for a safe, incident free stay, all haulers must adhere to the following standards, as this is a heavy industrial site.

It is the responsibility of the hauling company to ensure that each driver receives this training, and that new drivers are oriented to the site (including loading practices). **A training DVD supplied by Carmeuse should be used to cover the first section. 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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Carmeuse takes safety very seriously☐ Tanker hatches must be closed prior to arriving (or leaving) the site.☐ Open box loads must be tarped☐ Obey all signs, especially speed limits☐ When dumping (i.e. coal trucks)<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Ensure the area is clear around your truck (50' radius)o Watch for overhead structures & wireso Keep box 10' away from overhead structureso Only 1 truck at a time☐ Do not drive with a box up☐ Outside the cab of your truck, personal protective equipment (PPE) is required:<ul style="list-style-type: none">o ANSI/CSA approved hard hato Safety glasses with side shieldso Long pantso Safety boots (no shoes)☐ During winter, be aware of frozen loads.<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Park under a kiln if possible and necessaryo If possible, treat the inside of the box for easier material flow☐ Report all incidents to Carmeuse (your company will need to investigate as well)☐ Fall protection is mandatory when there's a danger of falling, such as on top of your tanker.☐ Fall protection includes<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Full body harness (belts are not allowed for fall arrest) and eithero Lanyard with arresting device (i.e. shock absorbing lanyard) tied to an overhead anchor point, oro Self retracting lanyard (SRL)☐ Follow the 3-point contact rule when climbing up or down | <ul style="list-style-type: none">☐ Lime is a corrosive irritant that may irritate wet skin, eyes and lungs – always avoid unnecessary contact.☐ Wet lime is very slippery☐ We expect everyone to leave the way they arrived.☐ There is nothing we do that is worth getting injured.☐ When using a Carmeuse fall arrest station with a SRL, attach the line directly to the D-ring on your harness. (Do NOT use a lanyard between your harness and the SRL)☐ A safety belt can be used for fall restraint (the tanker is equipped with 2 cables and the belt is tied on both sides)☐ In the event of an incident, do not disturb the scene so that a proper investigation can be conducted.☐ You may not be under the influence of illicit drugs or alcohol. Carmeuse reserves the right to require drug and alcohol testing.☐ In Ontario, there is no smoking allowed indoors and inside vehicles, as per Ontario Smoking Act☐ Smoking is only permitted in designated areas☐ High visibility clothing such as a traffic vest is required.☐ Truck wash stations must be used prior to leaving the site (to minimize track-out of dust onto public roads)☐ All dumping must be on a flat level surface to avoid tip over.☐ When dumping, nobody can be within 50'☐ Trucks are not be moved while the box is in raised position (except to clear the tailgate)☐ There is no dumping of foreign material allowed on site. Trucks must be free of foreign material.☐ Do not use cell phones while driving. |
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Carmeuse employees will report violations of the safety rules. By signing this document you commit that you will comply with the requirements of Carmeuse. Failure to follow these rules will result in Carmeuse revoking your authorization to drive on our site.
