

Visitor Safety Orientation

All visitors (*anyone other than employees of this facility, contractors, truck drivers [product haulage] and delivery personnel*) shall receive safety orientation if they intend to go into the lime-producing and shipping operation. This includes milk of lime.

This safety orientation is effective for 1 year.

Vehicles

- ☐ Maximum speed limit is 30 km/hr unless otherwise posted
- ☐ Be aware of road conditions and heavy equipment operations
- ☐ Seat belts are mandatory
- ☐ Vehicles must yield to pedestrians and heavy equipment

Alarms - signs - postings - directions

- ☐ Obey all alarms, signs, postings, and employee directions

Personal Protective Equipment

- ☐ Wear CSA approved hardhat and safety glasses with side shields while out of a vehicle, in all areas except these specific controlled environments:
 - ☐ Main office, including propane storage
 - ☐ Other offices, Lunch rooms, Locker rooms
 - ☐ Warehouse,
 - ☐ Kiln control room
- ☐ Other PPE as required by the facility host, consistent with the purpose of the visit, such as:
 - ☐ Hearing protection in noisy areas
 - ☐ CSA approved safety footwear
 - ☐ Sleeve shirts and long pants (over the ankle) in operational areas
 - ☐ Respiratory protection in dusty atmospheres
 - ☐ A full body harness and lanyard when working at heights greater than 6 feet with no guard rails
 - ☐ Gloves

Equipment Operation

- ☐ You are not allowed to use or operate any Carmeuse equipment unless specifically instructed. If you need assistance, speak to your facility host
- ☐ Do not approach equipment in operation, as operators may not be able to see you
- ☐ Do not walk in heavy equipment paths

Slips and Trips

- ☐ Wet lime is slippery - Use handrails at all times, watch where you step, and always use caution when walking on wet surfaces
- ☐ Be aware of uneven ground. Walk around loose stone on catwalks

Dock Hazards

- ☐ Do not climb on stockpiles

Lime

- ☐ Lime is a corrosive irritant and will burn skin, eyes and nasal passages - always avoid unnecessary contact
- ☐ Do not disturb lime spills or piles
- ☐ While touring never touch or rub eyes
- ☐ Use water or a dilute vinegar solution flush to remove Lime from the skin
- ☐ Notify your facility host if you get lime dust in your eyes

Emergencies and Evacuations

- ☐ Contact any employee for emergency first aid.
- ☐ Emergency medical services number is 911.
- ☐ In the event of an emergency plant evacuation, all personnel will meet at the main office.

Smoking

- ☐ Smoking is only allowed in designated areas

Mobile Equipment and Pedestrians

- ☐ Always proceed cautiously as heavy equipment operators may not see you or your vehicle
- ☐ Riding outside the cabs of mobile equipment is prohibited

General

- ☐ Report to Kiln Operator when in operational areas without a facility escort
- ☐ Sign in and out for each visit
- ☐ Must not travel beyond Main Office without consent from facility host
- ☐ Must wear visitor tag during visit

Injuries, Accidents, & Unsafe Conditions

- ☐ All accidents or injuries must be reported to your Carmeuse contact

Hazard Communication

- ☐ Do not handle chemicals unless trained to do so

Plant Hazards

- ☐ Overhead hazards are prominent throughout the plant – be aware of your surroundings
- ☐ Do not travel out of visual range of your escort (if applicable)
- ☐ Watch for debris on floors and catwalks, avoid tripping hazards
